The course aims to build confidence in decision-making and give participants the skills and information necessary for successful salvage operations. Participants will learn how to document, triage, handle, treat and pack a selection of water and smoke damaged materials typically found in collections, including ceramics, books, archives and works of art. By the end of the course, participants will be able to handle damaged objects safely, prioritise treatment, use emergency equipment and materials and apply first aid to a selection of objects.

Participants are requested to wear sturdy shoes and clothes that they don't mind getting wet or soiled.
